Community Library Mississippi Goes Virtual

The Community Library Initiative was formed by a small group of citizens in the fall of 2016 seeking to develop community led library programming designed to increase literacy, early learning, the love for reading, and provide spaces for intellectual exchanges and contests.

Community Library Initiative was renamed **Community Library Mississippi**. The organization incorporated March 21, 2019 as a non-profit corporation in Mississippi. The organization obtained its nonprofit status in July of 2019.

Mission Statement: To inspire intellectual growth through intellectual and cultural learning.

Purpose: Community Library Mississippi is a charitable organization formed to create community library spaces in neighborhoods across Mississippi and to promote literary and intellectual programs.

Community libraries & literacy

Library literacy efforts provide public spaces where families can spend time reading and learning together.

Children gain fluent literacy skills from school and from reading for pleasure. Research shows that student academic performance is higher among those whose parents read to them in their early school years (4 to 8).

Modern libraries

Modern libraries have beanbag chairs, short shelves with book covers facing outward, prompting discovery, family friendly, and are connected to parks, walking trails, retail space, outdoor decks, and other amenities.

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library (literacy resource)

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is an important book gifting program that mails free, high-quality books to children from birth until they begin school, no matter their family's income.
